- The scholar will receive **Rs 41,000/-** per month as SRF for the subsequent two years (only if the candidate publishes research papers in Q1/Q2 journals within the two years).

Candidates with a Master's Degree in English or related field (55% marks and above) and a valid UGC-NET and GATE certificate can apply for a direct interview. Other candidates will have to appear for the Entrance test and Interview to qualify.

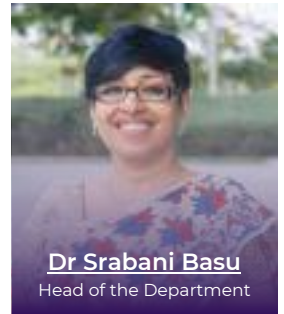

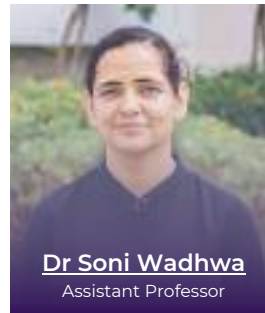

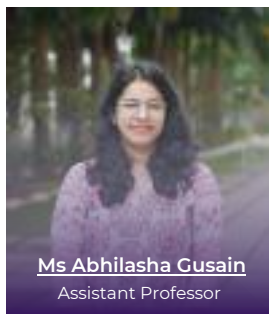
