
Message from the **Vice Chancellor**



Admissions at Easwari School of Liberal Arts


At Easwari School of Liberal Arts, we believe that academic performance is not the sole criteria for judging the potential of the students. Apart from the marks secured in the Board examinations, our expert counsellors infer the potential of each candidate through a lengthy discussion before rolling out the admission offer.

Admissions Process

Eligibility:

- ▶ A minimum aggregate score of 60% or equivalent grade point in Class X
- ► A minimum aggregate score of 60% or equivalent grade point in 12th Standard / Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) / Intermediate (First and Second year) from any Indian education board recognised by the Board of Higher Secondary Education
