### Why Study History at SRM University-AP?

#### **UNIQUE CURRICULUM**

Designed to equip students with the knowledge of historical processes, events, and transformations in the world and Indian History from the Stone Age to the contemporary world. The curriculum is designed under the following broad categories:

- Foundational Courses (e.g., Emerging Technologies, Understanding Human Minds)
- Ability enhancement and Value-Added Courses (e.g., Community Service, Critical Thinking)
- · Indian History Courses (Ancient, Medieval and Modern)
- World History Courses (e.g. History of Central Islamic Land, History of Latin America and Africa)
- Thematic Courses (e.g. Introduction to Gender, Understanding Caste)
- Courses on Regional Histories (e.g., South Indian History)
- · Research-Oriented Courses (e.g., Seminar and Dissertation)

#### **CHOICE-BASED CREDIT SYSTEM**

Where students have the flexibility to choose some courses from other Disciplines/ Schools in the University.

#### MINOR

The students of SRM University-AP have an option of obtaining minors from other disciplines of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences such as Economics, Psychology, English, and Journalism.

#### OPTIONAL 4<sup>TH</sup> YEAR AND TRAINING FOR HIGHER EDUCATION

The three-year Honours programme is extendable to an optional fourth year. The programme is fine-tuned to make the students aware of the cutting edge research being done worldwide in the discipline of History. Further, we train them to prepare for admissions in world-class universities including the **Ivy League institutions** for their higher studies. It also gives them the provision to submit a BA thesis which is a pre-requisite in applying to premier universities in the **USA and Europe**, facilitating a smooth transition to higher studies without losing an additional year.

#### HISTORY WITH A PURPOSE

The curriculum has been comprehensively set to train students to become professional historians with regular internship opportunities. Besides this, students are also trained for various other national and international competitive exams such as **UGC NET, PSC, GRE, and TOEFL**.

#### **INFRASTRUCTURE**

SRM University-AP offers a wide range of facilities and resources to support students. The library on the campus provides an extensive collection of books and journals on History. The students have 24x7 access to online journals and other valuable online resources required to hone their writing and research skills. Students also have access to the dining area, hostels, grocery store, Health Centre & Pharmacy, Bank with ATM, Post Office and other amenities. The University is built on the idea of **Green Campus** and is designed by Perkins+Will, the American architecture firm that specialises in educational institutions.

#### **FACULTY & AREAS OF INTERESTS**

**Dr Megha Yadav- PhD in History, JNU** - Her research explores the Ideas of gender relations and their performance and the socio-religious dimension of the Tantric Buddhist practices in Early Medieval Eastern India, Nepal, and Tibet.

**Dr Aqsa Agha- PhD in History, JNU** - Her areas of research interest explore larger themes of Gender, State, and Politics in Medieval India.

**Dr Lekshmi Chandran- PhD in History, JNU** - Her area of specialization is the social history of pre-colonial Kerala (which includes certain parts of the present-day state of Tamil Nadu).

**Dr Maanvender Singh - PhD in History, Central University of Sikkim -** His areas of research interest are Constitutional and Judicial Epistemology of Caste, State, and Politics in Post-colonial India.

**Dr Manaswini Sen - PhD in History, University of Hyderabad -** Her areas of research interest are History of Labour in the Global South, Intellectual History of Revolutionary epistemologies in the Global South and Economic History of South Asia.

#### CURRICULUM

The curriculum of the history department is designed as per the New Education Policy and duly passed by the Board of Studies. The core principle of the History department is to focus on interactive learning through critical thinking as against rote learning and performance in examinations. The courses contain the necessary knowledge in the subject for pursuing a higher degree in social sciences, from an inter-disciplinary and multi-disciplinary.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

60% and above aggregate marks in any stream in 12th standard or equivalent.

#### **SELECTION PROCEDURE**

Step 1: A panel interview for shortlisted candidates will be conducted. A provisional Admission Letter would be given to the candidates based on their overall performance.

Step 2: The final admission offer would be rolled out to all the provisionally admitted candidates on fulfilling the eligibility criteria, with proof of their Class 12 results.
