Rules and Regulations

1. Eligibility:

 The competition is open to students enrolled in classes 8 to 12 from any school in India.

2. Theme:

The video must focus on showcasing lesser-documented aspects of Indian heritage, which could include

- Tangible heritage consists of items or things that exist in physical form, such as monuments, artefacts, artwork, tools etc.
- Non-tangible heritage exists in non-physical form as living heritage and includes practices, representation, expression, knowledge, skills
- Natural Heritage can be categorised as landscape, flora, fauna, and peoples' diverse ways of living in their natural ecology.

3. Original Content:

- All video entries must be the original work of the participant.
- Plagiarism, the use of copyrighted material without permission, or misrepresentation will result in disqualification.

4. Video Length:

• The maximum duration of the video must be less than 5 minutes.

5. File Size and Format:

- The video file size should not exceed 1 GB.
- Accepted formats: MP4, MOV, AVI, MPEG.

6. Language and Subtitles:

• The video can be in any Indian language or English.





 If the video is in a language other than English, English subtitles or a Word file must be provided.

7. Ethical Standards:

- The content of the video should adhere to cultural sensitivity and ethical standards.
- Entries depicting any form of discrimination, violence, or inappropriate behaviour will be disqualified.

8. Permissions and Clearances:

- It is the responsibility of the participant to obtain all necessary permissions and clearances for any identifiable individuals, locations, or intellectual property featured in the video.
- By submitting a video, participants agree to allow SRM University-AP, Andhra Pradesh, to use their content for promotional purposes.

9. Submission Limit:

 Only one submission per participant is allowed. Multiple submissions will lead to disqualification.

10. Judging and Decision:

• The decision of the judging panel will be final and binding.

Submission Guidelines

1. Video Upload:

- o Participants are required to upload the video file directly to the submission form.
- o Ensure the video is less than 5 minutes in length and the file size is below 1 GB.

2. File Naming Format:

The video file/folder should be named as:
ParticipantName_Language
For example RishabhRanjan_English.mp4





3. Form Submission:

 Along with the video, participants must fill out the provided Form with all the necessary details.

4. Confirmation:

 After submitting the form and video, participants will receive an email confirmation acknowledging their entry.

5. Deadline:

 The last date for submitting entries is **November 30, 2024.** No late submissions will be accepted.
